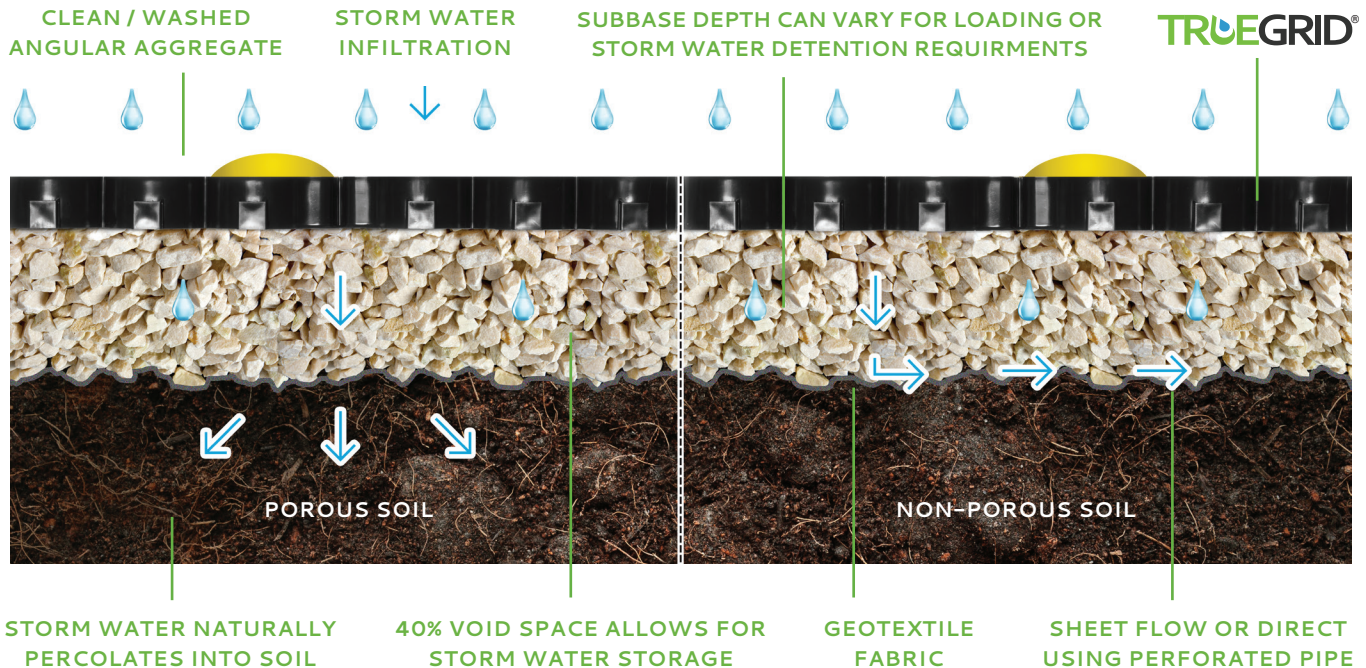

HOW TO CALCULATE STORM WATER DETENTION CAPACITY

Detention Capacity = TRUEGRID Area (A) x Total Aggregate
Depth (d) x 40% Void Space = $A \times d \times 0.40$

WHERE:

d = Depth of Subbase + TRUEGRID Height

EXAMPLE:

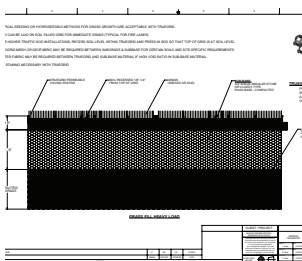
1 Acre Lot, TRUEGRID PRO PLUS, 8in Sub Base
Fill & Sub Base - 3/4" Clean/Washed Angular Stone
Detention Capacity = $A \times d \times 0.40$

WHERE:

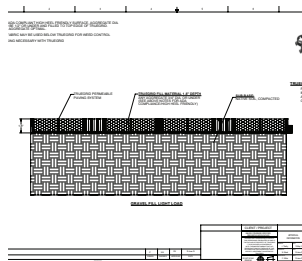
A = 1 Acre = 43,560 sf
d = 8 in + 1.8 in = 9.8 in = 0.8 ft
Detention Capacity = $43,560 \times 0.8 \times 0.4 = 13,939 \text{ cf}$

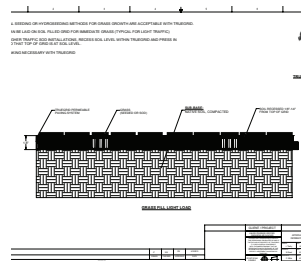
1. Grass Fill Heavy Load
