Helpful Formulas and Information

Here are some simple formulas to calculate how much product is needed.

If you prefer, simply contact us and we will be happy to assist you!

Squares & Rectangles

Area: Length x Width = Square Feet (sq. ft.)

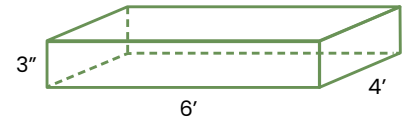
Depth: Inches Deep ÷ 12 = Decimal Depth.

Cubic Feet: Area x Decimal Depth = Cubic Feet (cu. ft.)

(Example: 6' length x 4' Width = 24 sq. ft.)

(Example: Depth = 3"/12" = 0.25)

(Example: 24 sq. ft. x 0.25 = 6 cu. ft.)



How much product do I need?

If you are buying material buy the Yard:

Cubic Feet ÷ 27 = Cubic Yards Needed

6 cu. ft. ÷ 27 = .22 cu. yds. (about 1/4 cu. yd.)

If you are buying material by the Ton:

Weight per Cubic Foot x Cubic Feet to cover = Tons Needed.

If the Product weighs 100 lbs. per cubic foot and you need 6 cu. ft, then 100 x 6 = 600 lbs. ÷ 2000 = 0.3 Tons

Circles

Area: Radius² x 3.14 = Square Feet (sq. ft.)

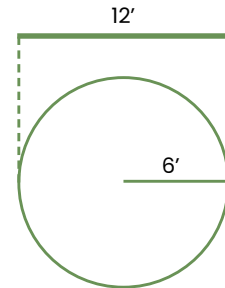
(Example: If Diameter = 12'; then (6' x 6' x 3.14 = 113.1 sq.ft.)

Circumference: Diameter x 3.1416. = Linear Feet

(Example: Diameter = 12' x 3.1416 = 37.7 Linear Feet.

Please note: Circumference is the running feet around the border of a circle.)

Rules of Thumb

- A ton of most loose stone products will cover about 80 sq. ft. (spread 3" deep).
- A cubic yard will cover about 108 sq. ft. (spread 3" deep).
- A ton of most loose products is equal to about 1/2 to 3/4 of a cubic yard - depending on the product (stone versus soil, etc.)
- Always plan for compaction for areas over 6" deep. Compaction for sand and soil is about 15 to 20%.

Terms we use:

River Rock – Rounded rocks of various size and color. Usually they actually did originate from a river bed!

Pea Gravel – Small, usually rough-edged rocks of varying size and color. Seldom larger than 3/4" in size.

Chat – Fine, gravel-like material usually consisting of limestone or dolomite.

Cobblestone – Larger, rounded stones of various size and color. Can be set in sand or mortar for paved surfaces.

2-man boulder – Large boulder, moveable by 2 strong people with good lifting technique.

Crusher Run – Rock material made up of limestone, granite, or other base rock. Crushed and screened to size and mixed with finer stone dust to make bonding easier.

FBD-Full Bed Depth stone – Wall stone that is between 3"-5" deep (measured front to back).

Veneer Stone – Natural or manufactured stone that is about 1-1/2" deep (measured front to back).
