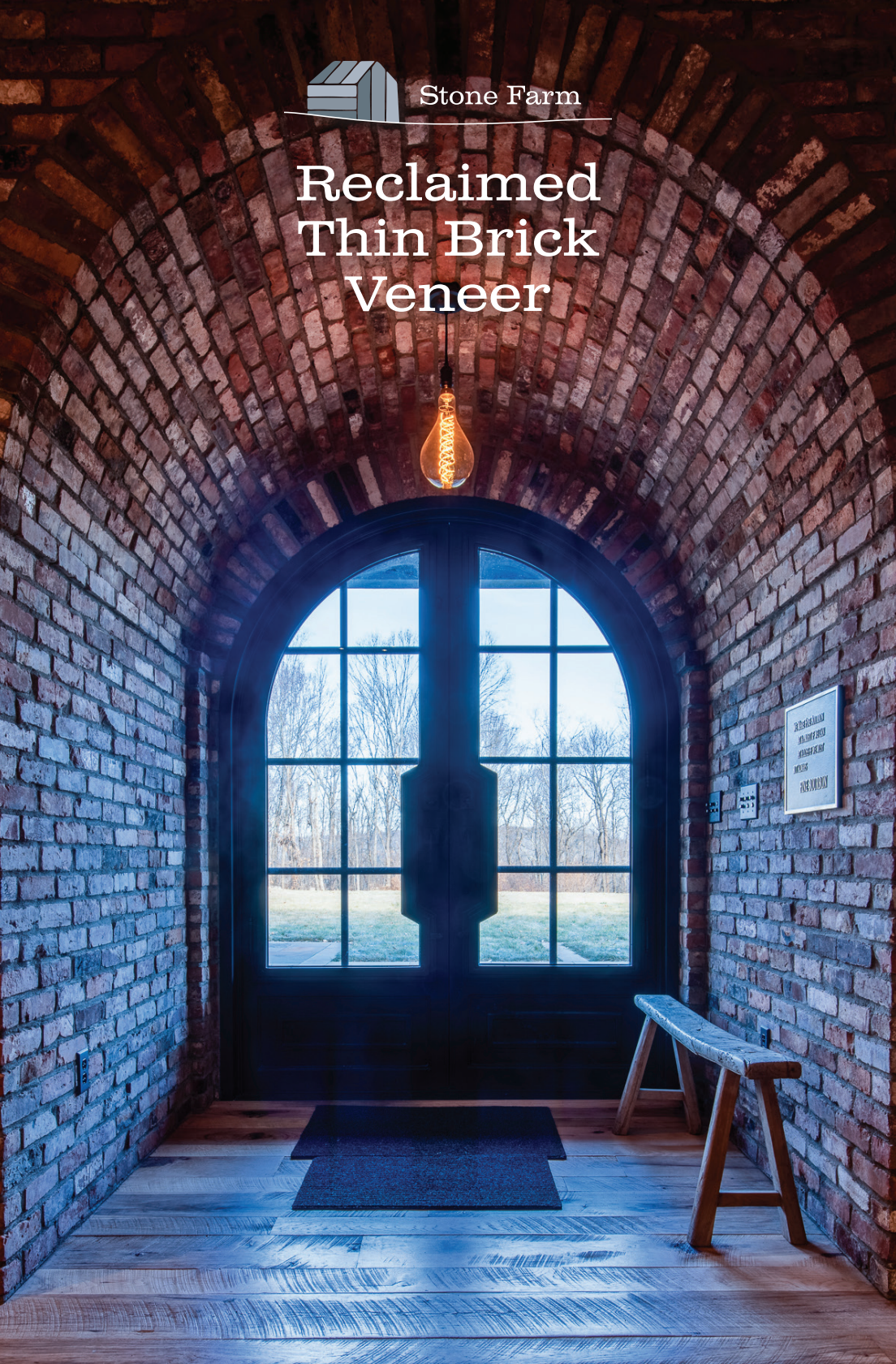

History Brought Home

Stone Farm scours the world to bring recycled, beautiful antique brick to numerous commercial and residential projects all across the country. We slice the salvaged bricks into a thickness that can be used as wall veneer or floor tile and carefully curate the bricks to provide a consistent blend to our clients.

Whether you are creating a small kitchen backsplash in your home, or adding history to your restaurant with a large accent wall, our reclaimed thin brick veneer makes it easy.

Look ahead for design ideas and how light and mortar can enhance the beauty of your brick.



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New England Mill Blend

Salvaged from old factories, mills, and schools around New England, this blend is an ideal accent material. The color is a mix of deep reds and terracotta oranges found in the Gilded Age brick structures of the Northeast, however, we mix in white tones and blackened "soot stained" pieces as a result of fire damage and natural weathering.

Antique Grey Blend

When our clients began asking about grey brick for their design projects, we went across the world to find our Antique Grey reclaimed thin brick blend. As grey clay is most readily found in the southwest region of China along the banks of the Yangtze River, Stone Farm has partnered with reclamation teams in that area to bring this new product to America.

This towering fireplace was clad in our Antique Grey bricks to create a stunning, modern focal piece with gravity and soul.







Mill Blend Floor Tiles

We also offer Floor Tiles made from our New England Mill Blend reclaimed brick. For flooring, we cut the top of the brick (rather than the face) as the larger surface area is more consistent with traditional brick floors and can be laid in a variety of patterns and sealed to provide a highly durable surface.

This photo shows how we slice our reclaimed bricks to make floor tiles to install easily over wood subfloor.









Perfectly Imperfect

Our clients choose Stone Farm reclaimed thin brick veneer because they love the way the variations and imperfections enhance the individuality of their projects. As you can see in the detail (left) of the photo above, chips, broken corners and variable lengths and sizes create the authentic feeling of a real brick wall with the convenience of adhering the veneer directly to prepared drywall or plywood substrate.





Light Effects

Choosing your color blend is only the start of creating the finished effect of your reclaimed thin brick project. The same brick can look very different based on the available light. Check your brick sample in the area you plan to install it. The light-filled loft above equalizes the tones, while the enclosed shower to the left pops the color variation.





Mortar Magic

How your mason mortars your reclaimed thin brick veneer can also have a huge impact on the final appearance. Both the color of the mortar and the type of joints changes the “look” of the wall. For example, a wide, deep set mortar joint (top left) looks different from the wine cellar on the right where you see very little mortar in the joint. At the same time, darker mortar (bottom left) creates a different feel than the white mortar used in the kitchen backsplash on the right. Meanwhile, above, we asked the mason to “point” the brick for a clean look with white mortar.

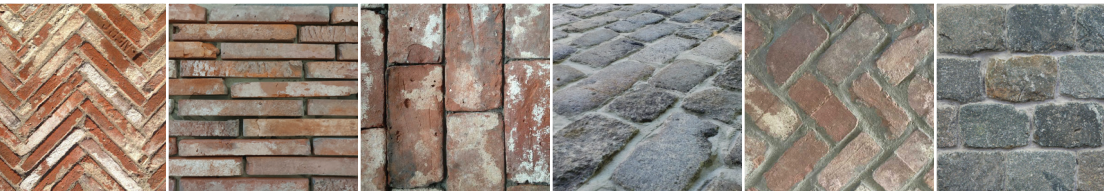


Endless Variety
