define the series.

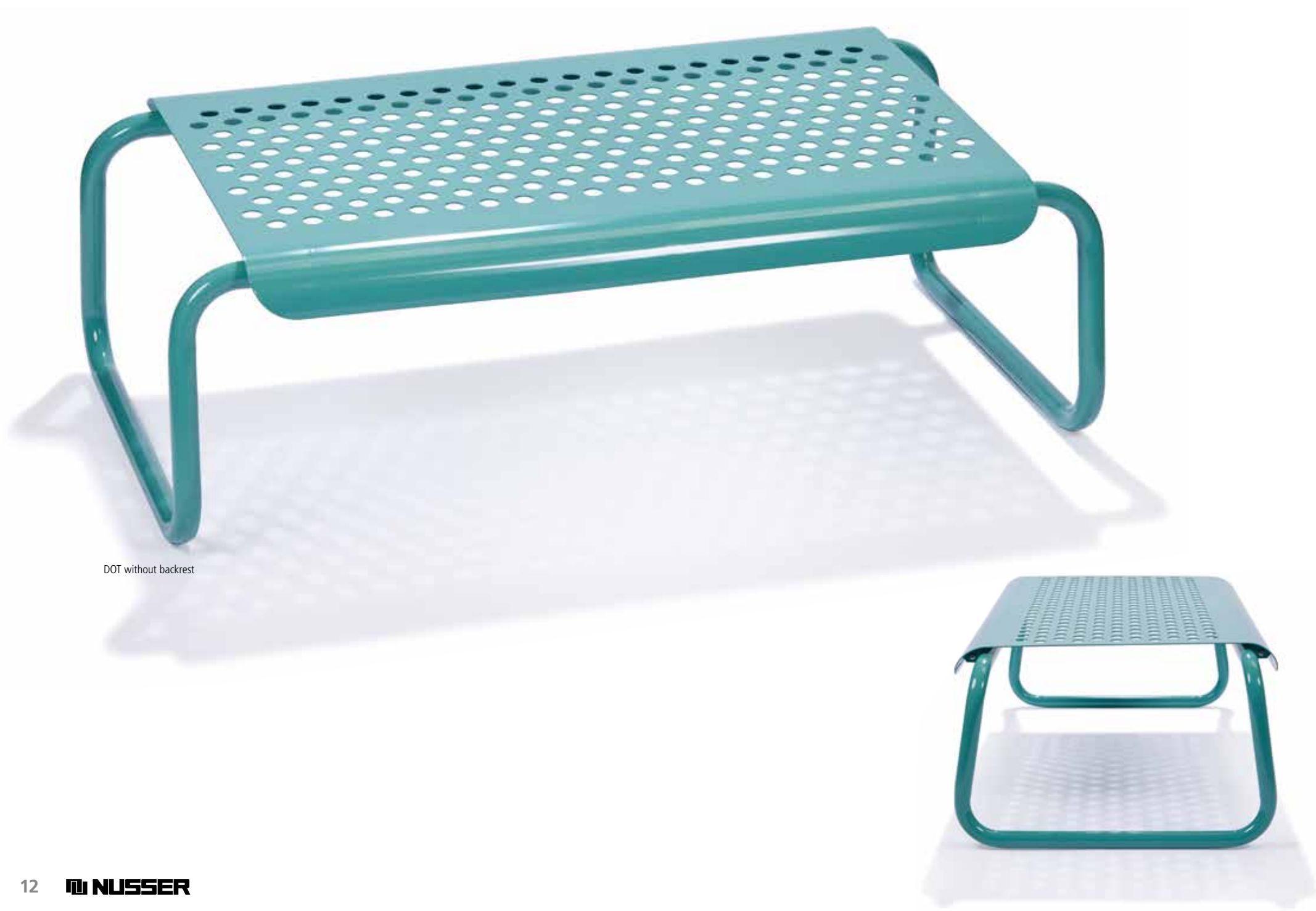

The result is durable, versatile seating solutions that enrich public spaces, invite people to linger, and add a distinctive architectural accent to their surroundings.

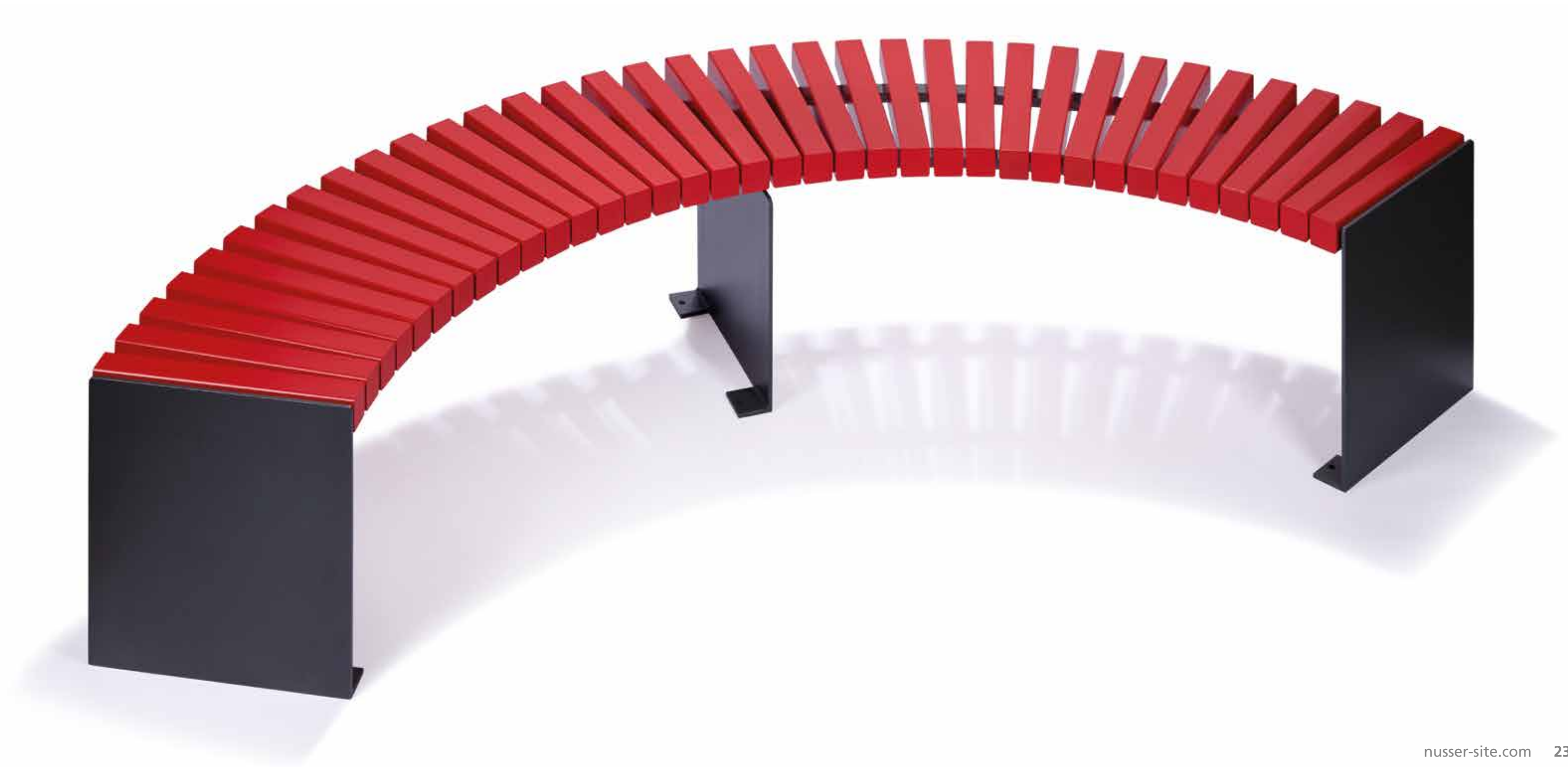

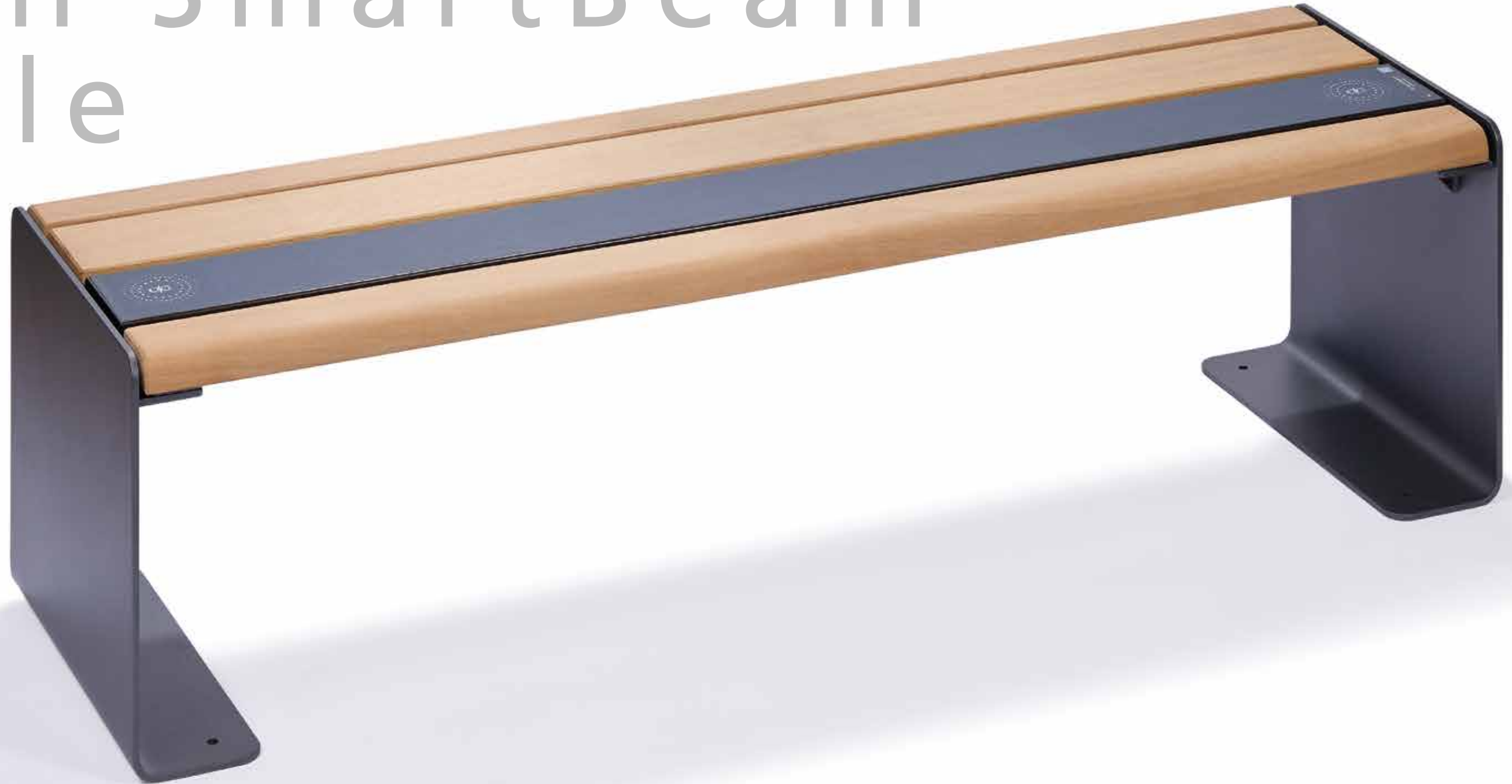

All wood shavings produced during manufacturing are compressed into briquettes and automatically fed into our heating system. Our vehicle fleet is gradually being converted to electric mobility, and at our sites in Winnenden and Waldbrol, we have installed partially public charging stations.

Since 2009, we have been an FSC®-certified company, processing only wood from responsibly managed forests.

Our certificate number is SCS-COC-001802, and our license code is FSC® C012729.

This certification guarantees that our wood comes exclusively from responsibly managed, sustainable forests. Please ask specifically for our FSC®-certified products.
